The cafeteria opens at 7:30 for breakfast. Only students who are eating breakfast or arriving via CUSD transportation (bus) are allowed on the campus. There is NO supervision at LCC before 8:00 and no student is allowed on campus until 8:00. At 8:00, students may go to the playground.

NOTES FROM THE OFFICE

- **EARLY PICK UP** – When picking up your children early from school, **please be prepared to present a photo ID.** In order to verify that individuals who are picking up students are authorized to do so, all individuals, including parents will be asked to show ID, before we release a student to them. It is for the students safety that we do so. Thank you for your understanding.
- **DROP OFF** - Please, do not use the bus lane to drop off students.
- **PARENTS ON CAMPUS** - It is great seeing parents involved with their children, but it is very important to **stop by the office and get a pass when you visit LCC.** A badge must be worn at all times while on campus. If you are just stopping by to have lunch with your child or to be out with your child during recess, you need to stop by the office first. This is for the safety of your children. Any time a parent does not have a badge school personal may ask that parent to go to the office to obtain one.
- **CUSTODY** - if your household is involved in any **custody issues** regarding a Little Chico Creek student, please make the office aware of them right away! Bring in all your paperwork to the office so that we may be aware of any and all situations regarding custody of your child(ren)
