If you are new to Shasta School, WELCOME! If you are returning ... WELCOME BACK! We are off to a great start. What a great group of children we have at Shasta School. We have a new teachers to Shasta. Please welcome Ms. Rendall who is teaching third grade.

A special thank you to Tim and Ron, our custodians, who did a wonderful job over the summer getting our school ready. We have a terrific PTO. They have done so many wonderful things for our kids. Please plan on joining our PTO!

We are accepting applications for parents interested in supervising during lunch recess. This is a paid position. If you are interested, please pick up an application in the office.

Our parking lots are packed as usual. Please drive carefully! About 95% of our students arrive and leave school in cars. Please be aware of the red zones in our front parking lot. This is a FIRE ZONE and it is a NO PARKING area at all times. This year, the fire marshal will be ticketing unattended vehicles. Last year, the penalty fee was \$110.00. The yellow zones are for pick-up and drop off of students. If you are in the yellow zone, please stay in your car and pull forward as space is available. **We ask that you do not get out of your car in the yellow zone.** This is for both before and after school.

Students may arrive on campus no earlier than 7:45. After school, students must be picked up by 2:50. Your child's safety is so important to us. We do not want your child on campus unsupervised before 7:45 or after 2:50.

Whenever someone visits our campus, they must first come to the office and SIGN-IN as a visitor. As a visitor, you will be given a VISITOR BADGE or PASS. Students who have appointments must be signed out in the office by a person on the OFFICIAL EMERGENCY CARD. When a student needs to leave school before 2:35, you will be given a pass to give to their teacher so they can leave with you.

Volunteers must fill out all the proper paperwork to work in classrooms or drive on field trips. Two references are required as well as a TB test. These forms must be completed with the start of each school year.

If anyone is interested in running for a position on our School Site Council, please let me know. The Site Council is an advisory group to the principal. There are 5 parent representatives who hold 2 year terms and 4 staff members who also hold 2 year terms on the council. If you are interested in running for a position, please let me know by Friday, September 5th.
