#### 5. DISCUSSION CALENDAR

- 5.1 Dr. Cynthia Kampf reviewed the 2002-03 California Assessment System. One major change is that CAT 6 will replace the SAT 9 when students start taking end of the year achievement tests next spring. It, too, is a norm-referenced multiple-choice, fill-in-the-bubble test which has the primary purpose of allowing comparison of California students to students across the country.
- Dr. Kampf reviewed the 2002 Growth Academic Performance Index (API). The 2002 API reflects SAT 9 tests and the California Standards Test for English/Language Arts. Previously, API scores reflected only the SAT 9.Next year, after the SAT 9 is replaced by the California Achievement Test, 6th edition, and students start taking the California Standards Test for Math, about 60 percent of the API will be based on California standards for academic content. Eventually the API will be based on the CAT 6 test, the California tests for math and English/language arts for all grades, the California Standards Test for social science, grades 10 and 11, and the high school exit exam, grades 10 through 12. Attendance and graduation rates will soon be added to the API to give a fuller picture of how each individual school is doing. For 2002, Chico Unified's 22 schools were assigned growth targets from a low of one to a high of 14. Only six of the 22 schools failed to meet their growth target for this year.

- Jim Sands reviewed the CUSD 2002-03 re-Opener to the CUTA. The CUSD proposed to open Article 22, Peer Assistance and Review (PAR). Specifically to revise Article 22.1.2.A as follows:
  - ?? The Joint Committee shall control 50% of all funds received for the program referenced in this Article. No more than 5% of said amount shall be used for administrative expenses.
  - ?? The remaining 50% of said funds shall be utilized for certificated staff development in a manner directed by the District.
- 5.5 Randy Meeker reviewed Resolution No. 866-02 relative to the GANN appropriations limit for 2001-02 and 2002-03.
