Due to a bid irregularity this project was revisited, with more time spent on how drainage could best be handled. The project again went out to bid and the new lowest bidder came in at \$237,000. This exceeds our current approved allocation for this

project. We ask that another \$30,000 be allocated, \$17,000 to cover the base bid and \$13,000 for project contingencies.
