**NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF APPROVING A CHANGE IN  
STATUTORY SCHOOL FEES IMPOSED ON NEW RESIDENTIAL  
AND COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL CONSTRUCTION PURSUANT  
TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 65995 AND EDUCATION  
CODE SECTION 17620**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Board of Education of the Chico Unified School District (“School District”) at its regular board meeting to be held on Wednesday, June 22, 2016, commencing at 6:00 p.m., in the Pleasant Valley High School, Library, located at 1475 East Avenue, Chico, CA 95926 will consider approving an change in the statutory school fees (“Level I School Fees”) that may be imposed on new residential and commercial/industrial construction located within the boundaries of the School District pursuant to Government Code Section 65995 and Education Code Section 17620.

A report entitled “School Fee Justification Study” was prepared pursuant to and in accordance with applicable law, which includes information and analysis demonstrating the relationship between new residential and commercial/industrial development and the School District’s need for the construction of school facilities, the estimated cost of the school facilities, and justification for the levy of Level I School Fees on new residential and commercial/industrial development.

The School Fee Justification Study and any related documents regarding the proposed adoption of the Level I School Fees will be available for public review, commencing Friday, June 10, 2016 during normal business hours at the School District’s administrative office, located at 22455 Carmichael Drive, Chico, CA 95928.
