
### LCAP Priorities



- 1. Quality Teachers, Materials and Facilities
- 2. Fully align curriculum and assessments with Common Core State Standards
- 3. Provide opportunities for meaningful parent involvement and input
- **4. Student Achievement** as measured by CASPP, API, EL reclassification rate, rates of college and career readiness, etc.
- **5. Student Engagement** student attendance rates, drop-out rates, graduation rates.
- **6. School Climate** suspension rates, expulsion rates.
- 7. Course Access student access and enrollment in all courses required for graduation.
- **8. Other Student Outcomes** assessments in other areas of required study.

- **Goal 1.1:** All CUSD students will have highly qualified teachers, current, standards-aligned materials, current technology and facilities in good repair.
  - ▶ 2014-15 Action
    - Maintain 100% compliance with Williams Act requirements regarding teacher qualifications, instructional materials, and facilities.
      - \* Status: Met
- **Goal 1.2:** By 2018, 100% of CUSD students and teachers will have regular access to the technology they need for curriculum, instruction and assessment.

### ▶ 2014-15 Action 1

- Purchase devices for classrooms and teachers per district technology specifications and needs identified.
  - ★ Status: 1,500+ Chrome books purchased with Common Core Implementation Funds

### ▶ 2014-15 Action 2

- Provide teacher in-service on device hardware and applications.
  - ★ Status: In progress

### ▶ 2014-15 Action 3

- Maintain appropriate level of support for devices and infrastructure with additional IT staff (including instructional aides - technology).
  - \* Status: In progress. Instructional Aides for Technology have been hired at selected sites.

### ▶ 2014-15 Action 4

- Promote awareness of community resources available to assist low-income families providing technology in the home.
  - ★ Status: In progress


### ▶ 2014-15 Action 1

### ▶ 2014-15 Action 1

- Provide opportunities for teachers to work with grade or course-alike peers to unpack and back-map the standards, and to share their work with others (staff meetings, district staff development days, etc.).
  - ► Status: In progress

### ▶ 2014-15 Action 2

- Create and administer CCSS aligned district and site formative assessments (through grade/department meetings, district-wide meetings, collaboration time, and staff development)
  - ► Status: In progress

### ▶ 2014-15 Action 3

- Utilize instructional coaches (with focus on literacy/ELA, math, and ELD) to support teachers in implementing rigorous standards-aligned instruction for the classroom and identified subgroups.
  - ► Status: In progress. ELA and Math instructional coaches in place K-12.

### ▶ 2014-15 Action 4

- Support adult learning around instructional design, with a focus on using student evidence, through peer observation / peer rounds.
  - ★ Status: In progress

### ▶ 2014-15 Action 1

- Identify existing pathways through high school and obstacles currently preventing all students from staying on track for college and careers, and implement a plan that provides access for all to college and careers.
  - ► Status: In process. Collaborating through Butte College Career Pathway Planning Grant to develop and implement new pathways.

### ▶ 2014-15 Action 2

- Research and implement ways to provide all students K-12 the academic support and enrichment to stay on grade level. Options might include: all day TK/ kindergarten, ways to encourage parent participation, broaden scope of secondary course offering
  - ► Status: In progress

**Goal 3.2:** Increase student achievement at all grades and in all subject areas on state, district, and site assessments.

- Provide professional development to all teachers in working with English Learners.
  - ► Status: In process

### ▶ 2014-15 Action 1

• Provide training for parents/guardians to learn about school programs, supports, and activities to increase active participation in school with their student(s).

### ▶ 2014-15 Action 2

 Train staff, including TCM and counselors, in strategies to include parents on campus during the school day and at meetings in the evenings.



 Provide parents training at elementary sites to support parental oversight of school attendance.


### ▶ 2014-15 Action 3

### 2014-15 Action 7

- Identify and implement specific strategies to improve school climate and student engagement. These may include such strategies as:
  - ▶ Improved campus supervision during school hours.
  - Student mentoring in all schools.
  - ► Reinstating the School Resource Officer program (in conjunction with the City of Chico).
  - ▶ Implementing Restorative Justice Techniques.
  - Tracking parent involvement at a site level and analyzing the data for improvement.
  - ▶ Providing more sports and after-school activities at each site.
  - ▶ Investigate leadership support at the elementary sites.
