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RECORDED VISUAL MATERIALS PROCEDURE

When a teacher desires to use recorded visual material, the teacher shall obtain principal approval prior to classroom use. In those cases, the principal may require that the teacher obtain written parental consent prior to showing the material. In this case, students without parent permission to view films or videos shall be provided an appropriate, comparable assignment. Students excused from viewing the material shall not be penalized.

Recorded visual materials include commercially and non-commercially produced visual recordings, including motion pictures, films, movies, videos, DVDs or other visual recordings, or portions thereof.

Teachers shall provide appropriate introductory and follow-up opportunities after the use of visual materials in order to extend their learning.

Visual material viewing during instructional time may not be used for recreation or reward unless the teacher has obtained prior administrative approval.

R-rated movie videos may be used at the high school level only, and then only if they are of exceptional merit, enhance the curriculum and are approved by the Principal. The R-rated videos must not contain nudity or explicit sex. If an R-rated movie is being used, parents must be notified of its nature and possible offensive content, and must give positive permission for their child, if under age 18, to view it. A student can opt not to view the video even if parental approval is given.
