#### **Background Information:**

On April 24, 2008, the District and CTA reached a settlement in the matter pertaining to the layoff resulting from the hearings requested by certificated employees who received a "Notice of Recommendation that Services Will Not Be Required" with respect to the 2008-09 school year. A Stipulated Decision was issued by Judge Lew. This settlement included the agreement that specific certificated employees can receive notices of non-reemployment for the 2008-09 school year. Resolution 1026-08 allows the District to send such notices.

#### **Educational Implications:**

There will be fewer classroom teachers in the District. As a result, many classrooms in the District may have more students for the 2008-2009 school year than in the past. Classes will be loaded as closely as possible to contractual limits. Staffing adjustments will be made throughout the year as necessary.

This resolution will provide the District with the needed flexibility to staff more tightly and to prepare for the possibility of reductions in categorical funding and/or changes in the manner in which those funds are provided to the District.

#### **Fiscal Implications:**

The district must reduce overall expenditures by \$8.5 million dollars. These layoffs will allow the District, depending on enrollment, to staff 30-40 fewer general fund classroom teachers. Any savings from categorically funded positions are, as of yet, undetermined.

# BEFORE THE BOARD OF EDUCATION of the CHICO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

Approval and Implementation of a Stipulated Decision between Affected Teachers and the District Concerning the Reduction in Certificated Staff Due to Reduction or Elimination of Particular Kinds of Service for the 2008/2009 School Year

WHEREAS, on February 20, 2008, and March 5, 2008, the Board of Education of the Chico Unified School District ("Board of Education") adopted Resolutions No. 1011-08 and 1014-08, respectively, relative to Reduction in Certificated Staff Due to Reduction or Elimination of Particular Kinds of Service ("Certificated PKS Reduction") for the 2008/2009 school year.

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2008, a Notice of Recommendation that Services Will Not Be Required with respect to the 2008/2009 school year was sent to three hundred forty-three (343) certificated employees in the manner prescribed by law and that the Board of Education was advised that such notices were sent.

WHEREAS, within the time limit specified in Education Code section 44949(b), two hundred eighty-eight (288) certificated employees initially noticed ("Respondents") requested a hearing to determine if there was cause for not reemploying them for the ensuing school year.

WHEREAS, each of the Respondents is a member of the California Teachers Association and is represented by Ms. Lesley Beth Curtis, attorney at law of Langenkamp & Curtis.

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2008, an Administrative Law Judge from the Office of Administrative Hearings, State of California, was scheduled to conduct a hearing concerning the Certificated PKS Reduction.

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2008, the parties reached a settlement, which was incorporated into a Stipulated Decision by Judge Jonathan Lew, a copy of which is attached and hereby incorporated by reference as though fully set forth.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. This Board of Education hereby formally approves the attached Stipulated Decision.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that by reason of the PKS Reduction, cause exists under Education Code sections 44949 and 44955 for not reemploying the certificated employees referenced in the stipulated decision for the ensuing school year 2008/2009, and that said cause relates solely to the welfare of the schools and the pupil thereof.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Superintendent or designee is authorized and directed to send notices of non-reemployment for the ensuing 2008/2009 school year to the affected certificated employees (as designated in the Stipulated Decision) that their services will not be needed for the ensuing 2008/2009 school year and that such notice be sent on or before May 14, 2008, by certified mail, return-receipt requested.

# **Background Information:**

Senior Cabinet consists of three current members: the Superintendent and the Assistant Superintendent, Business Services and the Assistant Superintendent, Human Resources. The fiscal year started with a senior cabinet of four positions, including a vacant position of Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services.

It is now proposed that the vacant position be eliminated for a 25% reduction in senior cabinet positions. In addition, all three senior cabinet members are volunteering to revise their individual contracts for a 3% reduction in total compensation (salary and/or benefits) for the 2008-09 fiscal year.

#### Fiscal Implications:

Savings of \$160,000 for the 2008-2009 school year.
