- Assistant Superintendent Meeker reviewed the major components of the 2006-2007 Preliminary Budget. With 5. the Governor's budget supporting education, the district will see substantial new revenue in 2006-07, which will 5.1 offset the deficit spending and use of one time funds from 2005-06.. For the first time in four years, deficit spending will be eliminated and fund balance will begin to increase. CUSD has projected 2006-07 total revenues of \$101,402,204 and expenditures of \$99,537,530 for an increase to fund balance of \$1,864,674. At 8:05 p.m. the Board entertained comments and questions. At 8:25 p.m. the public hearing was closed.
