#### 4. Discuss Committee Recruitment

### 5. Project Update

Julie Kistle reviewed the Newsletter, providing project status updates:

- ADA projects have been completed with exception of Phase 3 projects (at four elementary schools) scheduled to occur within timelines of Facilities Master Plan. Remaining funds to be placed towards technology in science labs including touch projector screens, new work stations, and google software as well as miscellaneous appliances at school sites.
- Chico Jr science building and site modernization including restrooms underway, remaining on schedule despite weather conditions.
- Marsh Jr new multipurpose building nearly complete and science building in progress with recent roof installation. Greenway has been collected water as intended with flood issues mitigated.

- Cabling Infrastructure/Wiring Projects substantial impact on classroom learning with wireless access and faster loading capacity.
- Security installation of lock blocks on all classroom doors, window coverings, fencing, and security cameras for single point of entry at most
- Chico High Esplanade Crosswalk on going discussions with City of Chico, meeting next Tuesday, January 19<sup>th</sup> at 6:30PM. Community recommendations include stop light at West Sacramento and Esplanade amongst other improvements.

#### 6. Potential New Bond Information

Kevin Bultema reviewed potential new bond information noting CUSD Board has provided direction to proceed with a November, 2016 measure. In conjunction discussed related tax details, polling results and survey, community input, and future projects noted in the Facilities' Master Plan.
