

Proposition 28: Arts and Music in Schools Funding

1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

Chico Unified School District (CUSD) utilized Prop 28 funding to impact students from Transitional Kindergarten through 12th grade. At the elementary level, CUSD hired several additional fine arts and music teachers. With the extra art and music teachers, CUSD provided additional art and music lessons to all TK-5th grade students, as well as one additional section at a junior high school. Each TK and K student received an additional 2,750 minutes of art and music instruction compared to the prior year. Each 1st-3rd grade student received an additional 1,650 minutes of art and music instruction compared to the prior year and all 4th and 5th grade students received an additional 1,725 minutes of art and music instruction compared to the prior year. The additional art and music instructional minutes provided to elementary students allowed for each elementary classroom teacher to receive preparation time without the use of substitute teachers. Prop 28 money was also used for the junior high school allowed for a new Ukulele Guitar class one additional section of music to be provided. Lastly, each comprehensive high school added coaches to work with their marching bands. These coaches taught drill captain, color guard, flag guard, advanced dance, drumline, and frontline skills.
