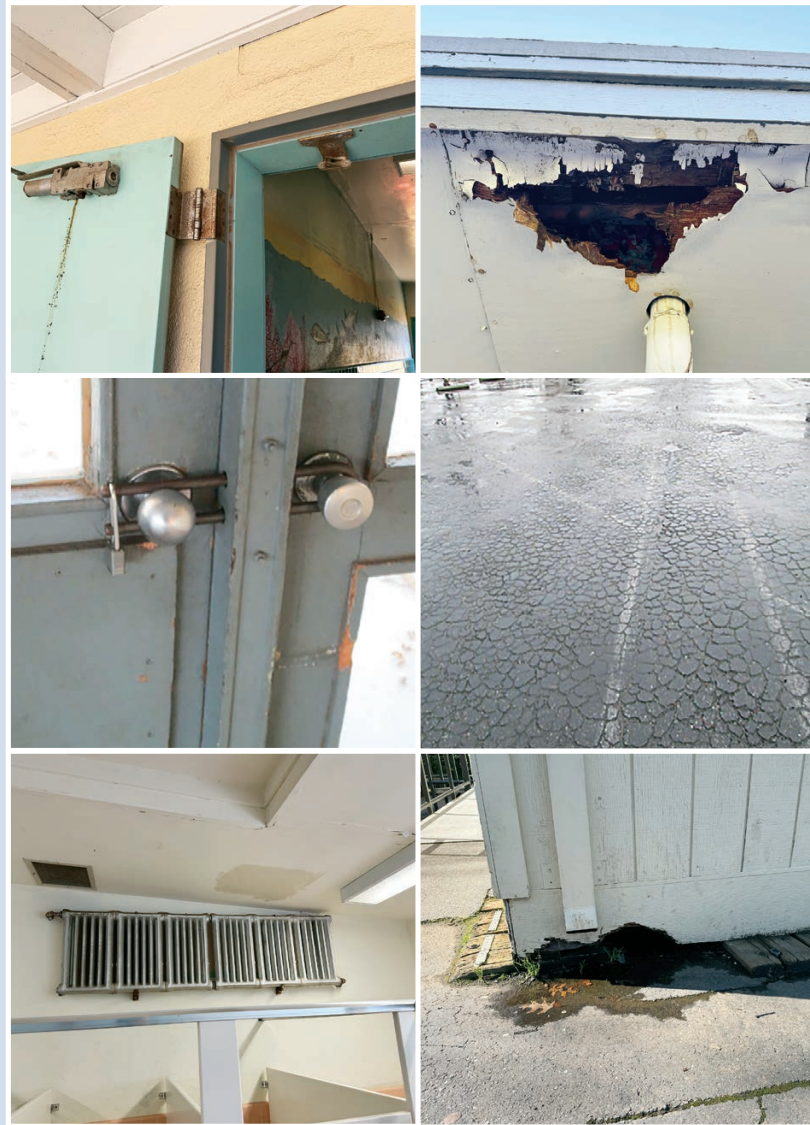
## Here is what you told us!

Over this past year we have had multiple committee meetings, updates at public Board meetings and community groups, plus a mailer with a mail-in and online survey. Your feedback has been critical as we develop our plan!

### SURVEY RESULTS

Here are the top eight critical facilities needs rankings:

- 1 REPAIR** deteriorating school roofs, windows, bathrooms, plumbing, wiring, as well as heating and cooling systems to provide a safe, healthy learning environment for students.
- 2 UPDATE** school heating and cooling systems.
- 3 IMPROVE** student safety and campus security systems including security fencing, security cameras, emergency communication systems, smoke detectors, fire alarms, and sprinklers.
- 4 UPGRADE** classrooms and facilities needed to support high-quality instruction in math, science, engineering, and technology.
- 5 EXPAND** facilities to support programs in reading and literacy for the youngest learners.
- 6 CREATE** modern labs, career technical facilities, and technical education so students are prepared for college, in-demand technical careers, and entering the workforce.
- 7 PROVIDE** up-to-date computer systems and technology to support 21st Century Learning.
- 8 EXPAND** facilities to support high-quality instruction in arts and music.
